he thinks no one is watching him?

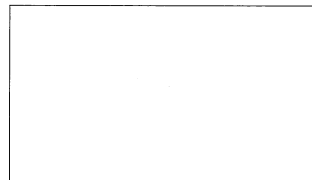
Wife : No, I don't. ?
